#### More precious than gold

As I was driving in the car a few days ago, my daughter asked me a question. She asked "Mummy, what do you think is more precious than gold?" As I paused to consider my answer, she went on, "Hugs. I would swap gold for hugs". Her question then led into a great conversation about all the things we would swap our imaginary gold for: smiles, best friends, time in nature, time with family, trees, love, stars, sunshine, music and so on.

We realised as we chatted that everything we had said couldn't actually be bought no amount of gold or money could buy these things we valued. Yet, this wasn't because they were unaffordable luxuries, but rather, because all the things we truly wanted were already freely available to everyone. We didn't need money to feel the riches of these gifts of life. These gifts are always free, and are offered to us each day. Yet, to receive them is not always easy.

How often do we end up too busy or distracted, or caught up in our own thinking or moods to notice the gifts being offered to us? It takes practise to live fully present to our lives, not dwelling on the 'what ifs' or the 'has beens', or judging or interpreting the gift or action. Rather, each day we need to intentionally find moments where we remember to stop and simply enjoy something that is. Whether you call it mindfulness, gratitude, presence or prayer is not important - making the decision each day to do it, is.

Some of these gifts also take courage, and that combination of vulnerability and strength that is required to develop and maintain deep and nourishing relationships. Skills we continue to grow and develop all our lives. Skills which will allow us to love ourselves and others and the world ever more fully. We know this isn't always easy, but it is always worth the effort.

Sophie Havill entered as a Level 4 Junior – 3rd on Floor, 2nd on Vault - 3rd Place overall!


Hannah Rowe entered as a Level 5 Senior – 3rd on Floor, 1st on Vault - 3rd Place Overall!




like gymnastics, you can do it anywhere, as long as you have the drive and the support of well-trained, enthusiastic coaches.




